Blagrove Meadows





We are seeking your views about Blagrove Meadows, a proposed new neighbourhood on the south west edge of Wokingham. Blagrove Meadows will be a beautiful new part of Wokingham that puts landscape and community at its heart.

Our proposal for the site can deliver:

- 8 10 hectares (about one third of the total site area) of new accessible green space with features to support wildlife, dedicated pathways and play facilities. This new ecologically diverse landscape (designated as SANG) would be accessible to all.
- Around 375 energy efficient (EPC B or better) homes, with a mix of sizes and types, including 40% affordable homes.
- A positive increase in ecology through new habitat creation, including extensive native wildflower, shrub and tree planting.
- A new community space for local meetings, events or classes.
- New access from Barkham Road and a network of footpaths and cycle routes along with sustainable travel plan to promote low carbon modes of travel.
